If approved for the Electronic/PC Access Service for your accounts, you will be issued a temporary PIN (Personal Identification Number). If approved, you will have access to the following:

- Online Application for loan
- Withdraw funds from your primary and joint share and share draft accounts by check
- Transfer funds from your primary and joint share and auxiliary accounts (total of 6 times per month)
- Unlimited transfers from your share draft accounts
- Obtain balance information from your primary and joint accounts
- Make payments from your primary and joint share and share draft accounts
- Access your line of credit accounts
- View and print copies of your cleared share drafts
- Review your VISA, ATM and Check Card activities
- View and print statements for your share, share draft and auxiliary accounts

Your account can be accessed under the Electronic/PC Access Service via personal computer. Services will be available for your convenience 24 hours per day. This service may be interrupted for a short time each day for data processing. We reserve the right to refuse any transaction, which would draw upon insufficient funds, exceed a credit limit, lower an account below a required balance, or other wise require us to increase our required reserve on the account. All checks are payable to you as a primary member and will be mailed to your address of record. We may set other limits on the amount of any transaction. We may refuse to honor any transaction for which you do not have sufficient available verified funds. The service will discontinue if no transaction is entered after numerous attempts to enter a transaction, and there may be limits on the duration of each access.
